Jack Ferracane is the Chair of Restorative Dentistry and Professor at Oregon Health & Science University, in Portland, Oregon. He received a B.S. in Biology from the University of Illinois, and an M.S. and Ph.D. in Biological Materials from Northwestern University. He is a past-President of the American Association for Dental Research and the Academy of Dental Materials. He is the recipient of the IADR Distinguished Scientist Wilmer Souder Award, the Academy of Dental Materials Founders Award, and the Hollenback Award from the Academy of Operative Dentistry. He is an honorary member of the American College of Dentists and the Oregon Dental Association. He is Editor-in-chief of a new journal published by the ADA and Elsevier entitled, JADA Foundational Science. He has authored or coauthored three textbooks on dental materials and operative dentistry. He has published and lectured extensively on dental materials, including dental composites, adhesives, amalgams, "bioactive materials", and practice-based dental research.
